Our core values are based on tolerance, transparency, and participation. Our primary areas of work include: education, women's empowerment, livelihood training, health camps, and social welfare.

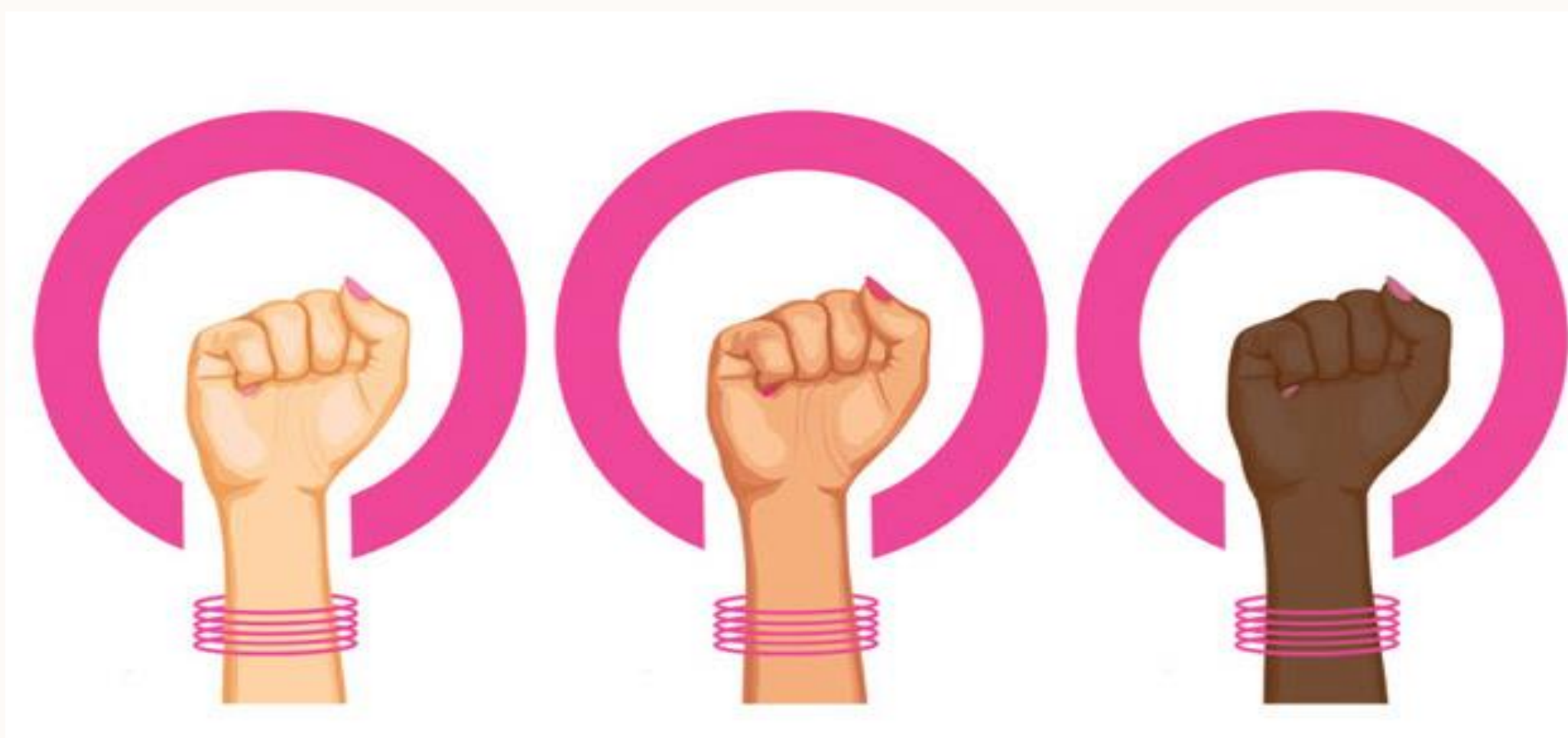

Year at a Glance: Programs and Financial Overview



The fiscal year 2021–22 was marked by diverse impactful programs and prudent financial management. We served a considerable number of beneficiaries through key initiatives focused on skill development, health awareness, and the celebration of significant community events. Our financial snapshot reveals an income of ₹1,22,319 against expenditures aligned to programmatic goals, ensuring maximum impact with efficient resource utilization. Skill development workshops enabled women to acquire valuable vocational abilities such as stitching and fashion design, thereby enhancing their economic independence. Health programs promoted awareness and preventive measures, especially crucial during the pandemic. Community celebrations fostered solidarity and cultural pride. The financial allocation was diligently tracked and appropriately balanced among these essential domains.

Monthly Activities Report – June 2021

This report documents the key activities conducted by Mehgawa Mahila Kalyan Samiti in June 2021, focusing on community health and wellness initiatives. The efforts highlighted include a COVID-19 vaccination camp and the observance of International Yoga Day to promote health awareness.



Under the leadership of Honorable MLA Ashok Rohani, a COVID-19 vaccination camp was organized in the community, with the committee actively encouraging residents to get vaccinated. Additionally, on June 21, the International Yoga Day was celebrated through a yoga camp emphasizing health guidelines such as mask-wearing, sanitization, and social distancing to promote the message "Practice Yoga, Stay Healthy."



Monthly Activities – July 2021

July's focus was on skill development and empowerment through meetings and training sessions. At the Udyanagar Sewing Center, trainees and municipal corporation members convened to discuss and disseminate information about the formation of self-help groups aimed at community upliftment.



Monthly Activities – August 2021

Important engagement with government authorities took place in August. The committee participated in discussions at the Collector's office with Collector Karmaveer Sharma, demonstrating ongoing collaboration with district administration. The Samiti was honored with a certificate of appreciation in recognition of its social initiatives.



Monthly Activities – September 2021

September marked active community participation in the Swachh Bharat Mission, aligning with the "Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav" celebrations. The initiative included cleanliness drives, tree plantation, and the construction of soak pits in the villages of Jaitpuri and Kakartala, promoting sustainable environmental practices and hygiene awareness.

Monthly Activities – October 2021

The committee inaugurated a free sewing training center under the Women's Self-Reliance Center initiative to empower women with vocational skills, facilitating financial independence. Additionally, a workshop on indigenous electric decorative lantern making was conducted in Gokalpur, providing hands-on training to women.

Environmental consciousness was demonstrated through the "Clean Indira Campaign" organized at Dumna Nature Park, focusing on the collection and proper disposal of plastic waste. In Gokalpur, discussions with rural women about self-help groups further strengthened community organization and socio-economic development.





Monthly Activities – January 2022

A new sewing training center was launched in January, provided by the Nehru Yuva Kendra, continuing the committee's commitment to skill development and women's empowerment. This initiative aims to expand vocational opportunities for local women and enhance their economic prospects through relevant training programs.



Special Program – Republic Day 2022

A special event was held on January 26th to commemorate Republic Day, honoring the spirit of India's constitution and democratic values. The program included various cultural and community activities designed to foster patriotic enthusiasm and collective pride amongst participants.

Awareness March – Menstrual Hygiene, February 2022

The committee organized a public awareness march in February to promote menstrual hygiene and break related taboos in the community. Through this campaign, participants were educated on safe practices and encouraged to foster a healthy dialogue around menstrual health.



Monthly Activities – March 2022

International Women's Day was celebrated extensively in Gokalpur, with significant contributions from councilor Rajesh Yadav. The event featured an exhibition and sales stalls showcasing products created by sewing trainees, highlighting the skill and creativity nurtured by the committee's vocational programs.



Monthly Activities – March 2022 (Continued)

Continuing their commitment to skill development, the committee operates a sewing training center in collaboration with Rani Durgavati University under the skill development scheme. This partnership enhances vocational education options available to local women, fostering empowerment through education and practical skills.

We remain committed to continuous improvement, embracing audit insights as opportunities for growth and ensuring fiduciary duties are fulfilled rigorously.



Financial Highlights: Income, Expenditure, and Audit

The society's financial stewardship during 2021-22 demonstrates transparency and fiscal responsibility. Total donations amounted to ₹1,21,100, with a modest surplus of ₹342, ensuring sustainability while maximizing program reach. The expenditures were aligned closely with income, reflecting prudent budgeting and resource allocation practices.

The audit conducted by P.C. Madan & Co., Chartered Accountants, confirmed a clean audit opinion, underscoring the society's commitment to compliance and accountability.

These financial results provide confidence to stakeholders and donors that their contributions are effectively utilized, promoting trust and encouraging continued support. The surplus, although minimal, signifies operational efficiency and the potential for incremental growth in future activities.



Future Goals

2022–23: Expansion, Digitisation, and Health

Building on our successes, the Mehgawa Mahila Kalyan Samiti has charted an ambitious roadmap for the upcoming year. Central to this vision is the expansion of vocational training programs to include digital skills and advanced tailoring techniques, aiming to enhance income opportunities for more women beneficiaries.

Complementing programmatic growth is the adoption of digital record-keeping systems, designed to improve data accuracy, facilitate monitoring, and streamline administrative processes. This shift will enable more effective impact evaluation and transparent reporting to stakeholders.

Additionally, community health camps are scheduled to extend vital health services and education, emphasizing preventive care and wellness. These camps will target maternal health, nutrition, and sanitation, thereby reinforcing our holistic approach to women's well-being.
